Week 5: There is a Place

In God's Big Story

When Moses went into the Tent of Meeting, God would meet him there, and they would talk just like two friends would do. Moses spoke to God for the other Israelites because they couldn't talk to God themselves. The Israelites were tasked with building a tabernacle according to God's detailed instructions, serving as His dwelling place among them. But that's not necessary for us today. Jesus, God's son, gave His life for us. When we put our faith and trust in Him, we become His child, and His spirit dwells in us at all times. We can talk to God at any time, just like we would talk to our best friend!
