Week 6: Not Just Gettin' Out of Egypt

## In God's Big Story

The Israelites faced a big decision at the Desert of Sinai. God had made a covenant with the Israelites, and they agreed to obey Him. However, their impatience led them to create and worship a golden calf, breaking the first two commandments of the Ten Commandments. God wants us to put him first and not let impatience lead us to make poor decisions.

**CRUCIAL** God is most important, so we put Him first!
